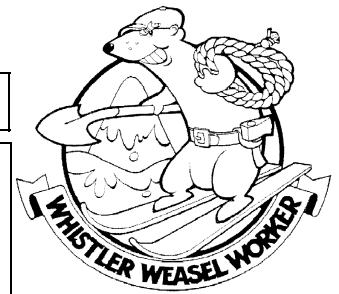

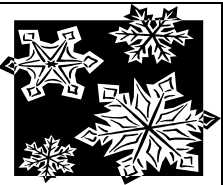
Please remember to recycle in the Beer Tent! Let's keep these races sustainable! It's the Weasel thing to do.

The Volunteer Recognition Program was created to thank all Weasels for their valuable time and efforts. Please note the following to know when you are eligible to receive your package:

If you work 6 days of the Canadian Nationals between January 30th and February 13th you qualify for the Karbon Poncho.

If you work 4 days of the World Cup between January 30th and February 24th you qualify for the World Cup Jacket.

Distribution of the World Cup Jackets will commence on February 14th. Those leaving before February 14th can complete a form for the coordination of obtaining your jacket. Forms can be found in the Beer Tent or at morning check in.

If you are a volunteer for the World Cup races and are in Whistler and able to assist at the Canadian's right now, we'd appreciate the help! Please report to the Coordinator at the top of the course for instructions and assignments.

As of February 14th the Creekside underground parking lot will have an attendant checking that any vehicles carrying World Cup volunteers has at least 3 people per car. Please organize your ride now to avoid any issues at the parking lot.
