The cats will be out Thursday morning at 3 am again to knock down snow accumulation. Slipping excess snow, buttoning up and double checking all safety systems are part of today's program.

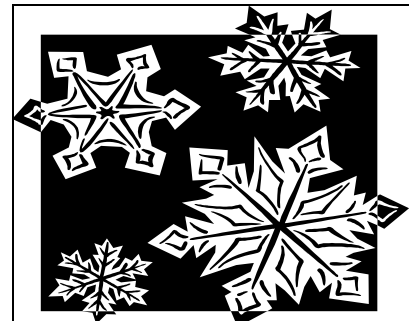
Hot Bands Coming to Whistler for World Cup
